## NATURE TRAIL LA SÈQUIA



LA SEQUIA NORTHEASTERN PENINSULAR 

- The starting point for this nature trail is Reclosa dels Manresans in Balsareny, where the waters of the Llobregat are captured using a semi eliptical dam. This first section of the canal is underground. The meeting place of many aquatic birds, this is an interesting place and an observatory post has been installed
- the opportunity to visit Balsareny Castle, although the trail itself continues towards the Santa María aqueduct, which the traveller will encounter just before the bridge which crosses the River Llobregat. At this point the visitor can enjoy a drink of water from the Sant Roc fountain before continuing on their way between the small orchards. The trail follows the banks of the Llobregat through riverbank woodland that gives way to an area of orchards that depend on the waters of La Sèquia. The first crossing offers

According to the records, in the 14th century, the municipality of Bages suffered a devastating drought that forced the inhabitants to call for better distribution to prevent future supply problems. The definitive solution to the problem came in 1383, when the construction of the 26 kilometrelong La Sèquia canal was completed to take water from the River Llobregat from Balareny to Manresa.

These routes take us to the countryside to discover the biodiversity and beauty of our precious natural heritage, and discover the villages, sights, traditions and people that are part of the unique cultural landscape of our country. le trails and traditional routes, for public use and enjoyment.

Since 1993 the Ministry for Agriculture and Fisheries, Food and the Environment's Nature Trails Program aims to restore former transport infrastructures such as railway tracks, catt-
